The Piano Teachers Congress of New York has created the **Piano Salon**, a yearly piano recital exclusively for the adult students of its members.

The Piano Salon is a social event dedicated to the enjoyment of great music through playing and listening. Performing students share a piece that has been prepared with performance in mind, while non-performers participate as listeners. We encourage participation from adult students of all ages and levels who are willing to embrace performance as part of the learning process.

WMP Concert Hall is the setting for this year's Piano Salon. Performers are welcome to bring guests who are invited to enjoy wine and other refreshments during the recital. The Piano Salon is moderated by Co-Chairs Rosemary Caviglia and Tatjana Rankovich, who maintain a relaxed environment and help facilitate a positive performing experience.

## **Eligibility and Guidelines:**

- Performers must be 18 years or older and study with a member of PTC
- Compositions originally written for piano are recommended
- Works for four-hands are encouraged
- Memorization is not required
- Length of piece is not to exceed 7 minutes
